

CRITERIA FOR EASTERN COUNTIES SHETLAND SHEEPDOG CLUB JUDGING LIST

A3 List (Breed Specialist)

To have ten years active exhibiting experience in the breed.

Minimum of 7 years judging experience in Shetland Sheepdogs and have the support of Eastern Counties Shetland Sheepdog Club.

To have judged at one Shetland Sheepdog Breed Club Open Show or three Shetland Sheepdog Breed Club Supported Shows of not less than 10 classes.

To have judged a minimum of 120 dogs actually present, to include a Club Show.

To have bred and/or owned a minimum of 3 Shetland Sheepdogs when they obtained their first entry in the Kennel Club Stud Book. (Save in exceptional circumstances).

To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer, and passed the relevant examination, on Kennel Club Regulations and Judging Procedures.

To have attended a Points of the dog Assessment" conducted by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer and passed the assessment. (KC Policy 1/7/05)

To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer on Conformation and Movement (KC Policy 1/7/01)

To have attended at least one Shetland Sheepdog Breed Club seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and/or assessment by a Shetland Sheepdog Breed Club.

To have stewarded over a minimum of 12 days of any breed at KC Licensed Shows (excluding Exemption Shows)

A3 List (Non-Specialist)

To have judged at one Shetland Sheepdog Breed Club Open Show or 3 Shetland Sheepdog Breed Club Supported Shows of not less than 10 classes.

A minimum of 10 years judging experience in any other one breed

(to include 7 years in Shetland Sheepdogs) and have the support of Eastern Counties Shetland Sheepdog Club.

To have judged a minimum of 120 Shetland Sheepdogs actually present.

To have judged a further 250 dogs of any breed (or varieties)

To have awarded CC's in at least one other breed in the Pastoral Group.

To have attended at least one Shetland Sheepdog Breed Club

judging seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and/or assessment by a Shetland Sheepdog Breed Club.

To have bred and/or owned a minimum of 3 dogs of any breed when they obtained their first entry in the Kennel Club Stud Book.

To have stewarded over a minimum of 12 days of any breed at KC Licensed Shows (excluding Exemption Shows)

A2 List

Criteria as for A3 List.

If invited to judge by a society, would in principle be approved by the Kennel Club to award C.C's having been assessed by the Kennel Club approved assessors at two Open Shows and a Breed Club Open Show and ratified by the Kennel Club.

A1 List

Criteria as for A3 list and must be approved by the kennel Club and have awarded C.C's in the Breed.

B List (Breed Specialist)

Minimum of 6 years owning and/or exhibiting experience in Shetland Sheepdogs and have the support of Eastern Counties Shetland Sheepdog Club.

To have judged a minimum of 60 Shetland Sheepdogs actually present.

To have attended at least one Shetland Sheepdog Breed Club judging seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and/or assessment where applicable. (KC Policy as of 1.7.2001)

To have stewarded over a minimum of 12 days of any breed at KC Licensed Shows (excluding Exemption Shows)

B List (Non Specialist)

Minimum of 6 years judging experience in any one breed and have the support of Eastern Counties Shetland Sheepdog Club.

To have judged a minimum of 60 Shetland Sheepdogs actually present.

To have judged a further 150 dogs of any breed (or varieties)

To have attended at least one Shetland Sheepdog Breed Club judging seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and/or assessment where applicable. (KC Policy as of 1.7.2001)

To have stewarded over a minimum of 12 days of any breed at KC Licensed Shows (excluding Exemption Shows)

C List

To have owned and /or exhibited Shetland Sheepdogs for a minimum of 5 years or any other one breed with an interest in Shetland Sheepdogs and have the support of Eastern Counties Shetland Sheepdog Club.

To have stewarded 6 classes of Shetland Sheepdogs.

To have attended lectures, Breed Standard, Structure and Movement.

To have judged the breed at a Kennel Club Licensed event.

Promotion from one list to another will be automatic, subject to application by the person concerned. Details of higher level of qualification (which must be verifiable) must be supplied to the Eastern Counties Shetland Sheepdog Club secretary.

The judging lists have been recompiled in accordance with Kennel Club instructions, which require that the lists should be recompiled annually by the Club Committee.

The lists contain the names of persons who have satisfied the requirements of a Training of Judges Scheme (marked*), there are also names of persons who have not done so but are approved by the KC to award C.C.‘.

“This List contains judges who, if they were not on the B list prior to 31st December 2021 will have attended a Breed Appreciation day and passed the MCE. They meet the requirements of level 2 of the Kennel Club Judges Education Programme relevant at the time of application.”
